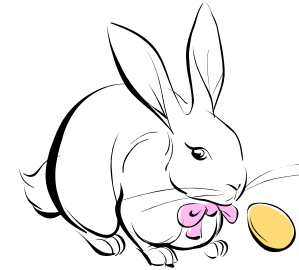
Visitors
